ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Date February 7, 1969

Articles of Incorporation of the Vista Redonda Mutual Domestic
Water Consumers' Association.

We, the undersigned residents of Santa Fe, County of Santa Fe,
and the State of New Mexico, do hereby voluntarily associate our-
selves together for the purpose of forming a Mutual Domestic Water
Consumers' Association under the provisions of the Sanitary
Projects Act of the Laws of 1965 of the State of New Mexico, rela-
tive to non-profit associations, as follows:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the Association shall be Vista Redonda Mutual
Domestic Water Consumers' Association.

ARTICLE II - Term

This Association shall exist for a term of fifty years.

ARTICLE III - Place of Business

The principal place of business of the Association shall be
at 223 Johnson Street, City of Santa Fe, County of Santa Fe, and
the State of New Mexico.

ARTICLE IV - Purposes and Powers

The objects, powers and authority of this Association shall
be:

(a) To associate its members together for their mutual bene-
fits collectively engaging in drilling, construction and installa-
tion of water works facilities and to carry on any related activity

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of business. Any benefits for non-members shall be subject to the discretion of the Board of Directors, but the Association shall not deal in the benefits of non-members to an amount greater in value than such as are handled by it for members.

(b) To buy, sell and otherwise deal in, as agent, commodities related thereto, and any other products or supplies that it may deem it expedient to handle after having received authority from the New Mexico State Health Department.

(c) To act as agent or broker for its members.

(d) To buy, lease and/or acquire, hold, and control, as owner or otherwise, personal property necessary, convenient, or proper in the conduct of its business. To erect, construct, or acquire any interest in and operate any buildings, warehouses, facilities, or machinery necessary and/or incident to its business.

(e) To buy, hold, own, vote, control, and exercise all the privileges of ownership in the stock and bonds of other corporations or associations engaged in any related activity.

(f) To obtain and disseminate information concerning more efficient sanitary water, or supplies, or sewage collection and treatment, or implements used by its members.

(g) To have and exercise all the powers granted, authorized, or allowed by the laws of the State of New Mexico to Mutual Associations.

ARTICLE V - Membership

This Association shall not have any capital stock, but shall admit members into the Association upon payment of an entrance fee of One Dollar, and other uniform conditions. This Association shall be operated on a cooperative basis for the mutual benefit of its members, and only people benefiting directly may be admitted

to membership. The voting powers of the members of this Association shall be equal, and each member shall have one vote only. There shall be only one official member from each dwelling unit.

ARTICLE VI - Directors

The general business of the Association shall be conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of five members, being the president, vice president and three other members all being members of the parent organization, and they in turn shall be governed by the State Health Department of the State of New Mexico.

The Board of Directors shall have full authority to exercise all the powers of the Corporation, except that they shall not have power to permit speculation, or to waive any requirement for bond, or cash dealing, or other provision for the safety and security of the property and funds of the Association or its members.

Election of Officers:

The President, Vice President and three members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting of the membership of the Association to be held during January of each year. The Secretary, Treasurer, and other officers which the Board of Directors finds necessary, will be appointed by the Board and will have to be members of the Association. All officers and Directors shall serve without remuneration.

Vacancies:

Should any vacancies occur in any of the offices of the Association the Board of Directors shall by a majority rule have the right to name a successor for the said office, except that in the event the office of the President becomes vacant for any reason, then the Vice President shall thereupon become the President with all duties and powers of the said office.

ARTICLE VII - Miscellaneous

Section 1. This Association is formed to operate upon a cooperative basis for the mutual benefit of the members.

Section 2. The members shall not be personally liable for the debts of the Corporation.
